Welcome

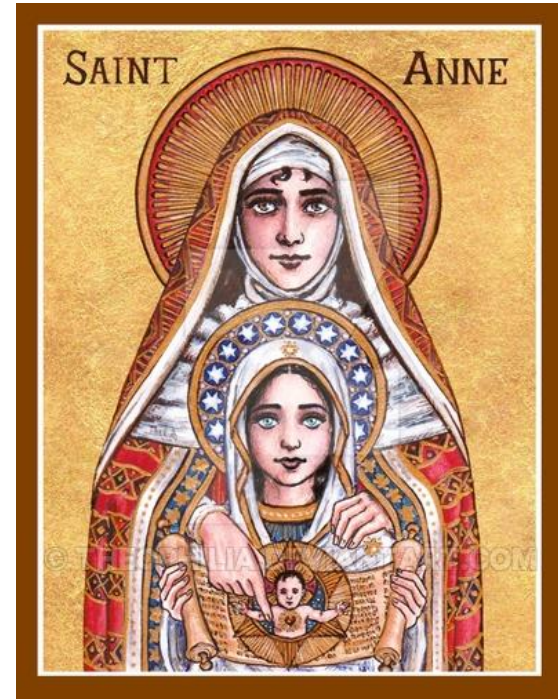
